BENEFIT CONCERT FOR LUTHER PARK BIBLE CAMP

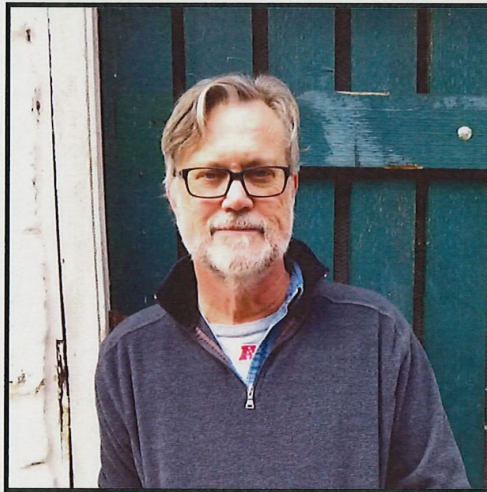
Saturday, Sept. 28 - 7:00 p.m. Featuring *Morpheus*
